Description: 48 count, 4 wall, beginner/intermediate line dance

Music: Cheri Cheri Lady by Modern Talking [/]

32 count intro

JAZZ BOX, JAZZ BOX TURN ¼ RIGHT

- 1-2 Cross right over left, step left back
3-4 Step right to side, step left together
5-6 Cross right over left, step left back
7-8 Step right to side, turn ¼ right, step left together

STEP PIVOT ½, FORWARD SHUFFLE (TWICE)

- 1-2 Step right forward, turn ½ left
3&4 Step right forward, step left together, step right forward
5-6 Step left forward, turn ½ right
7&8 Step left forward, close right beside left, step left forward

MONTEREY TURN, ROCKING CHAIR

- 1-2 Point right to side, turn ½ right and step right together
3-4 Point left to side, step left together
5-6 Rock right forward, recover to left
7-8 Rock right back, recover to left

SIDE ROCK, WEAVE (TWICE)

- 1-2 Rock right to side, recover to left
3&4 Cross right behind left, step left to side, cross right over left
5-6 Rock left to side, recover to right
7&8 Cross left behind right, step right to side, cross left over right

GRAPEVINE RIGHT, HITCH, GRAPEVINE LEFT, HITCH

- 1-2 Step right to side, cross left behind right
3-4 Step right to side, hitch left
5-6 Step left to side, cross right behind left
7-8 Step left to side, hitch right

CROSS, HALF CROSS, COASTER STEP

- 1-2 Touch right heel forward, hook right across left shin
3-4 Touch right heel forward, step right together
5-6 Touch left heel forward, hook left across right shin
7&8 Step left back, step right together, step left forward

REPEAT

TAG

End of wall 3 (3:00)

JAZZ BOX

- 1-2 Cross right over left, step left back
3-4 Step right to side, step left together
