COUNTRY CLUB STOMP

CHOREOGRAPHER – UNKNOWN

40 Count – Stationary Partner Dance

Music : Baby Likes To Rock It by The Tractors

Step Description – Closed Dance Position;

{ Mans steps listed. Ladies are mirrored except last eight counts. }

SIDE, TOGETHER, SIDE, TOUCH HEEL X 2

{ Man facing 12:00 O'clock }

- 1 - 4 Step Left to Left, slide Right together, step Left to Left, touch Right heel out at 45 degrees.**
5 - 8 Step Right to Right, slide Left together, step Right to Right, touch Left heel out at 45 degrees
{ as a suggestion: turn your head in same direction as you turn your heels. }

STEP IN PLACE, TOUCH HEEL X – 4

- 9 - 16 Step in place with Left, touch Right heel out at 45 degrees.**
Step in place with Right, touch Left heel out at 45 degrees.
Repeat above four counts again.

TURN, HITCH, STEP, TOUCH,--- STEP, HITCH, STEP, TOUCH

{ Drop mans Left & Ladies Right hands – Mans Right arm stays behind Ladies back }
{ Ladies Left hand stays on Mans Right shoulder }

- 17 – 24 {Turn to face 9:00 O'clock } Turn Left onto Left, hitch Right knee up, step forward on Right, touch outside toe with partners outside toe in front.**
Step forward on Left, hitch Right knee up, step forward on Right, touch outside toe with Partners outside toe in front.

STEP BACK LEFT, RIGHT, LEFT, STAMP RIGHT

STEP BACK RIGHT, LEFT, TURN RIGHT, TOUCH

- 25 – 32 Step back Left, Right, Left, stamp Right foot alongside of Left**
Step back Right, Left, ¼ turn Right onto Right to face partner and touch Left toe.
{ Rejoin Mans Left & Ladies Right hands }

GRAPEVINE LEFT - GRAPEVINE RIGHT { Ladies do rolling vines }

- 33 – 40 Step Left to Left, Step Right behind Left, Step Left to Left, Touch Right toe.**
Step Right to Right, Step Left behind Right, Step Right to Right, Touch Left toe.

******* As man does grapevines, he leads Lady with his Left hand as she does rolling grapevines.**
End in closed dance position. } { Lady also has option not to turn. }

REPEAT

******* This dance fits a wide selection of music from medium speed to very fast.**
Experiment and find your favorite.
